5. The Applicant must pursue a Bachelor’s Degree within HR, Finance, IT or Business.
6. The Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student as defined by the University and/or College.
7. The Applicant must provide the following documentation.
 - Copy of birth certificate
 - Proof of Caymanian Status
 - Proof of academic standing (final transcript)
 - Completed Grant Application form
 - 3 Personal and/or Academic References
 - Letter of acceptance from accredited University and/or College
8. The Applicant must not be a recipient of a scholarship or other monetary grant from another Recruitment Firm.
9. The Applicant must demonstrate financial need.
10. The Applicant must demonstrate strong academic ability.
11. The Applicant must have a strong desire and commitment to learn and develop their higher education.
12. The Applicant will receive a one-time payment of CI\$5,000 to be used toward supporting the achievement of their educational goals. (ex. tuition, books, school supplies, room & board)
